PRIVACY POLICY

1. Our Commitment to You

We understand the importance of maintaining the confidentiality and privacy of your information. By entrusting us with your information, we assure you of our commitment to keep it private. We have taken measurable steps to protect the confidentiality, security, and integrity of your information.

2. Collection of Information

If you decide to cooperate with us and become our client, we will require certain information from you. By entering into an agreement with us, you consent to the transmittal of your personal information outside the European Economic Area, in accordance with the provisions of the Processing of Personal Data (Protection of the Individual) Law of 2001.

4. Contacting You

For the purpose of administering the terms of our agreement, we may contact you directly by telephone, fax, email, or post. If you agree, we or any of our affiliates may also contact you from time to time by telephone, fax, email, or post for marketing purposes to inform you about products or services that may be of interest to you or to conduct market research.

5. Disclosure of Information

Under the agreement, we have the right to disclose your information in certain circumstances, including but not limited to:

- When required by law or court order
- When requested by any regulatory authority
- To relevant authorities for fraud, money laundering, or other illegal activities
- To credit reference and fraud prevention agencies, third-party authentication service providers, banks, and other financial institutions
- To our professional advisors
- To other service providers for record-keeping, email transmission, messaging, statistical purposes, or marketing
- To market research call centers for surveys
- When necessary to defend or exercise our legal rights
- At your request or with your consent
- To our affiliates and employees to further the agreement

6. Safeguard Measures

Your information is stored on secure servers. We limit access to your information only to those employees or partners who need it to carry out the agreement. We have procedures in place to safeguard and use your information, including requesting our affiliates and employees to maintain confidentiality. We will retain your information for as long as required by applicable regulations and laws.

7. Change of Information

We will change or delete your information in accordance with your instructions, except where we are required to retain it for regulatory or legal purposes.
