

1. To invest in a Strategy/PAMM, you must have an **Investment account**. If you don't have an **Investment account**, you can open one in the Traders Room Dashboard by requesting a new wallet.







Each client can have only one Investment wallet denominated in one of these four base currencies: **USD**, **EUR**, **GBP**, **BRL**.

2. To start investing, you must deposit funds into your Investment wallet.

This can be done by opening the Traders Room Dashboard and selecting the **"Deposit"** button, or by clicking **"Move money"** to transfer funds from an existing trading account.




3. To select a new strategy, go to "Investments" and then select "Browse Strategies".





Here, you will find a variety of existing strategies. You can then examine these strategies and compare them to find one that meets your desired **risk tolerance and potential returns.**

4. When examining each strategy, make sure to navigate to "Conditions". Here, you'll find important information, such as the minimum investment amount, withdrawal times, and collateral requirements.



5. If you have found the desired **Strategy/PAMM** you want to invest in, press the **"Invest"** button in the upper-right corner of the Strategy provider's profile.





6. After clicking this button, you will then have to select the Amount you want to **invest.**

If you wish to, you can also set a **Stop Loss** to mitigate any potential losses.

The next step is to carefully read the **Terms and Conditions** and sign them along with the **Power of attorney** agreements if you agree to the terms.



The final step is to press the "Invest" button, and then you're done! All you need to do after this is to monitor the trades and their performance.



If it is your first time investing via a Strategy/PAMM system, we recommend you read the tooltips in the **"Invest in strategy"** to get familiar with fees and how they work.

Tier is a commission the strategy owner takes from the profit depending how much the investor has deposit to his account.

Example

10% with 1000 20% with 0

If investor deposit is 100, then the strategy owner will take a 20% tier commission if the strategy owner outcome of the closed trades result in a profit (if the trading results in a loss, no tier commission will be charged). If same investor deposit an additional 300 to the same strategy owner, it is still 20%. But if he deposit 800 again, then his total investment is above 1000, and the strategy owner will take 10% commission.

The tier commission is calculated once per day using the difference in strategy balance between last rollover and current in case of profit.

Stoploss is the limit that the invested balance can drop to before it's automatically withdrawn from the strategy and transferred back to investment account. In case the balance is lower than the stop loss then the remaining funds is transferred. Since this is handled at rollover this can result in the investor losing more money than the stop loss settling.

The stop loss value is meant to mitigate the risk for an investor of losing the entire investment value.

During the nightly rollover for the strategy, all investment balances are calculated based on the daily change in strategy value.

If your investment value then is lower than the stop loss setting, your investment will be immediately cancelled and the remaining value will be returned to your investment account.

As an example, if on previous rollover your value of investment was 10,000 and your stoploss is set to 9,500 nothing happens.

If then on new rollover, your updated investment balance is 9,300, then stoploss will be triggered.

 $\mbox{\it Max}$ stop loss is an aggregated value of your existing invested amount in this strategy plus the new amount.
